



A Whole Child Approach to School Safety

A great deal of attention is being paid to school safety and security, following several high-profile incidents of school violence. The Whole Child approach describes "safe" as "each student learns in an environment that is physically and emotionally safe for students and adults." In this one-day action lab, participants:

- will take a deep dive into the Safe Tenet of the Whole Child and its ten indicators of success;
- will take away an approach to making key safety decisions from a global context that is proactive, rather than reactive to newsworthy events;
- leave with a plan for implementation.

Part of the day will be devoted to action planning. It is strongly encouraged that attendees represent a team of people with decision-making authority. This may include district or school administrators, crisis teams, school improvement panels, and/or security staff. Remember to include key members of your Board of Education who have responsibilities for security policy writing and oversight.
